Dear Resident:

As a reminder, three important tasks will take place between April 8, 2013 and April 19, 2013 in the reservoir construction area.

- 1) Rodent control and abatement will be in place within the boundaries of the construction site. **Please keep all children and pets away to ensure their safety.**
- 2) For public safety, the access road from Galloping Hills Road to the open space will be closed during construction through Fall 2014. All other open space entrances will remain open.
- 3) The contractor will begin mobilizing trucks and heavy equipment to the construction area.

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES: Heavy equipment sounds. Noise levels will remain within the City's noise ordinance levels.

WORK HOURS: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday
